Jurors called and Jury selected. Jury Sworn. Motion by Defendant that all witnesses in this case be excluded from the Court Room until called STATE'S ATTORNEY: to testify. Motion granted. Court adjourned at 4:30 p.m. to meet on Tuesday morning at 9:30 o'clock. - Fred A. Thayer Walter W. Baker 1966 May 10th Trial of case resumed before the Court and TRAVERSER'S ATTORNEY: Jury. Upon conclusion of the State's case, Motion was made by Defendant to strike out first degree Murder.
