Havre de Grace was not known as a station prior to 1841, but it was connected with East Harford Circuit prior to this time. Early meetings were held in the town School House and later in the Methodist Protestant Church. The first church was called Doory Chapel. It was built c. 1840.

In 1841 Havre de Grace was made a station by the Annual Conference. Circa 1855-1856 Doory Chapel was sold. A new church was built in 1857.

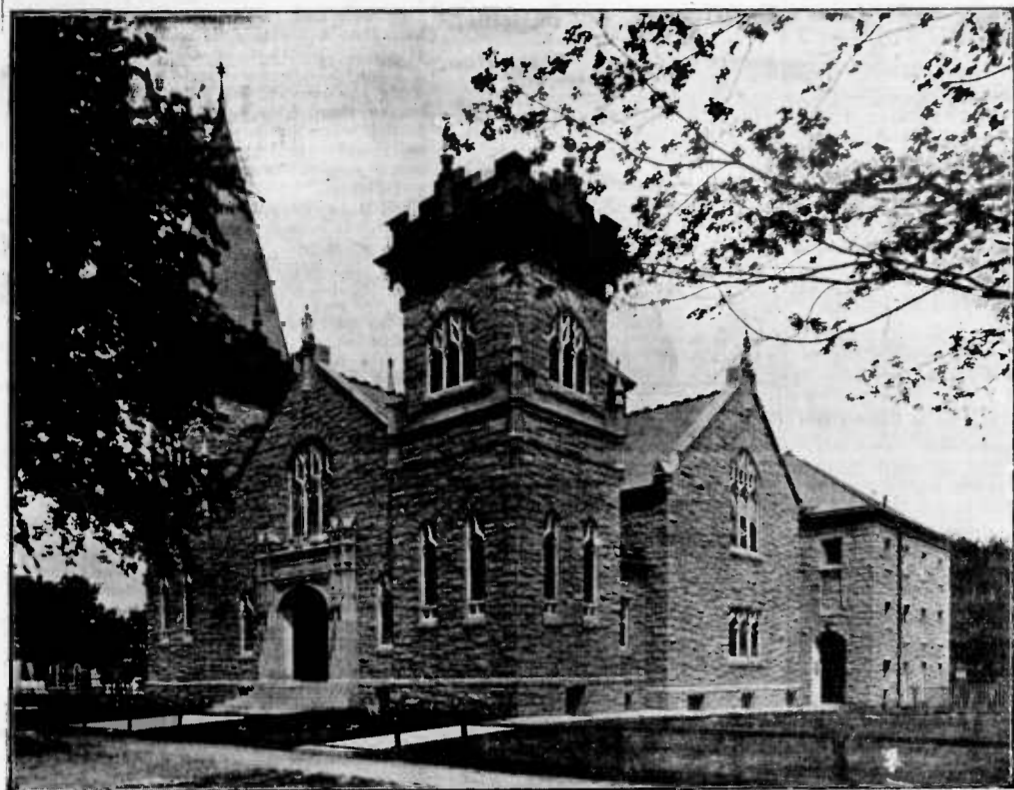

THE NEW METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH . .

TO BE DEDICATED
NEXT SUNDAY,
JUNE 8th, BY
BISHOP ANDREWS.



NEXT SUNDAY promises to be a red-letter day in the history of Methodism in Havre de Grace. The magnificent structure built through the liberal beneficence of Mr. Stephen J. Seneca and his good wife, Mrs. Annie E. Seneca, will be formally turned over to the church authorities and dedicated with services beginning on next Sunday, June 8th, with three services on that day and every evening during the week, (excepting Saturday), closing with all-day services on Sunday, June 15th. At the first of these services next Sunday morning Bishop Edward G. Andrews will deliver the dedicatory sermon proper. Specially prepared music will be rendered under the leadership of Prof. Nichols, of Baltimore, with Prof. A. K. Baldwin, of Aberdeen, as organist. While the new organ for the church has not yet been delivered, a large Kimball organ has been secured for this occasion.

The Rev. Edward Hayes, the indefatigable pastor of the church, has been untiring in his efforts to promote the success of these services, and the pulpit, during dedication week, will be occupied by distinguished ministers, and many former pastors of this charge will be present to renew their friendships of former years, one of whom, Rev. D. S. Monroe, of Shamokin, Pa., was pastor of the old church, just vacated, when its corner-stone was laid nearly forty-five years ago. Those who will occupy the pulpit on the different occasions are given below in connection with the services of the week.

With the erection of this handsome edifice, Mr. and Mrs. S. J. Seneca see the culmination of their fondest hopes and desires of many years, that the congregation of the church of their faith is provided with a suitable place of worship. The location, corner Union avenue and Congress street, is the most desirable one in the city, being central and convenient of access.

At a meeting held in the old church on Sunday, September 8th, the purpose of Mr. and Mrs. S. J. Seneca, to present to the congregation of this church a new stone church edifice, was officially made known to them, on condition that the members provide for heating, lighting, furnishing, etc., which was promptly accepted. That same day Messrs. S. J. Seneca, R. K. Vanneman and J. W. Foster were appointed the Building Committee.

On the next day, Monday, September 9th, ground for the foundation was broken, with appropriate ceremonies, in the presence of a large gathering. Mr. E. S. Sentman, to whom had been given the contract for its erection, pushed along the work of laying the foundation promptly and speedily.

On Tuesday, October 22nd, 1901, the corner-stone was formally laid, with interesting services, a large audience being present and assisting therein.

Tomorrow, Sunday, June 8th, just precisely nine months to the day since Mr. and Mrs. Seneca, announced their readiness to erect the church which have the proud satisfaction of presenting the magnificent building, which columns of type could not as plainly describe as the picture we print above.

We read of great cathedrals and churches of Europe, many of which consumed the energy and resources of countless generations of the several nations which erected them, during this long period of perhaps seven or eight centuries, the skilled artisans wrought with a diligence born of inspiration and hope, transmitting their special knowledge only to sons and the chosen few. The analytic mind of to-day can

this corner of Union and Congress avenues was practically a vacant lot. To-day it contains the masterpiece of church architecture in the State of Maryland. Observers who have traveled far and wide are unable to pick a flaw in its design, adaptability to purpose, enduring nature of its materials and elegance of its interior finish.

As we approach the church from any direction the first impression is that of great size; as we draw nearer, at each step almost, new and surprising effects force themselves upon us in rapid succession; first the soft gray tints of the Port Deposit stone, next the pleasing distribution of the light Indiana limestone trimmings, which in turn develop into beautifully wrought tracery, moulded panels and carved relief, so judiciously distributed, that the eye unconsciously follows the upward tendency through the pinnacles, until the rich chocolate brown of the top cornice, panels and battlements attracts the eye on upwards; a glance at the spire ends in a longing desire to see more. Naturally our anticipation carries us to the inside. We enter through the spacious front door, a long transverse vestibule, carried out in the old gothic gabled treatment, side walls wainscoted with rich veined and colored marbles the floor paved with real mosaic, bordered and paneled in pleasing and harmonious colors of rich marble. To the right and left great high gothic paneled doors admit us to the towers or inner vestibules, inviting stairways lead up to the great wide galleries, which are reached through deep, groined arched passage ways.

The auditorium proper is reached from the towers at the front and by two independent side entrances; these meet a double purpose; the one on the north opens to a common vestibule, from which we may enter the church, the choir, the Sunday school and the basement recreation hall. The south door is a smaller entrance way to the same sections of the building. We return to the main church auditorium and our expectations are fully realized. The most striking feature we behold in gazing in mute wonder about us, is the exquisite effect of the delicate stone tracery windows; these are filled with selected tints of opalescent glass and jewels, leaded in artistic lines producing a dream-like harmony in a decorative spirit in the three gothic ends over the galleries. The stained glass windows are wrought in the old medieval style of figure work; on the south the Plowman with his typical oxen; on the north the Fishermen drawing their nets on the Sea of Galilee, and on the west we have perhaps the finest example in America of the Good Shepherd. These windows were made in the studio of the well-known artist, Wm. Reith, of Philadelphia. Next in artistic effect is the finish. The woodwork of the auditorium and vestibules is the finest selection of quarter sawed oak, shaped, moulded and carved in the highest standard known. The altar rail, pulpit furniture, choir rail and organ front are made of selected San Domingo mahogany. The details are all in the same delicate style of gothic tracery which prevails in the windows. The pews, set in amphitheatre style, are of the finest quartered white oak, and are roomy and comfortable and present an inviting appearance. The ornamental plastering, the work of J. H. Pymer, of Delta, Pa., is wrought in a manner equal to the greatest of the old cathedrals. The ribs, grained arches, crouched caps and highly polished cluster columns are remarkable for their neatness and proportion; the electric and gas fixtures, the work of A. C. Mylander & Bro., of Baltimore, are the finest ever produced; the decorations, by Otto M. DuBran, of Baltimore, are beautiful, tasteful and artistic, and the furnishings are very quiet and lead a pervading tone effect through the interior; the steam heating, the

trace the development of logical construction and artistic rendering in the historic structures referred to, the details growing uniformly more refined and impressive as the work progressed. The result of that training has, under the theory of evolution, produced a distinct class of men who sooner or later occupy themselves with building or the Allied Arts. Individuals become interested, skillful, prominent or famous, in accordance with the opportunities which occurred to develop their latent talents and the fact with which they applied themselves.

Mr. S. J. Seneca, the projector of the edifice we are called upon to describe, early in life cast his lot with the multitude on the broad stream of commerce in the mad struggle peculiar to Americans; system, method and perseverance directed his ship safe in port. Many periods of calm during this tempestuous voyage favored the Aryan spark in his soul to assert its peculiar influence by causing its possessor to crave for some satisfying mental occupation, different from the ordinary routine process, that latent activity developed with a pronounced tendency towards artistic consistency and ideal ends in all things.

We do not know when the project of building the new church edifice was determined upon, but the method of proceeding was methodical and business-like.

An experienced architect was selected almost two years before the actual work of construction began. Numerous preliminary plans were outlined, utility and adaptability to purpose were studied over and over again, the conditions and requirements in the allotment of space were so clearly and definitely stated and the relative lay of the site were such that the ordinary form of church plans could not be applied.

An entirely new and original problem was confronted, and its satisfactory solution came about under the conditional process of development, the result as observed in the finished structure illustrates what can be accomplished at this stage of civilization by the forceful will power and generalship of one man, who by a single stroke switched on the forces necessary to accomplish his purpose. The potential energy thus released put in active operation the directing mind of the architect, W. L. Plack, of Philadelphia, who, by his patient, untiring study, developed the design, made all the calculations for sizes, strength and stability, the working drawings which illustrated every detail of construction and finish, wrote the specifications which described the kind and quality of material, inspected and directed the workmanship from start to finish.

Next came the builder, Mr. E. S. Sentman, who, by his long experience, wonderful skill and executive ability in handling men and materials, has built and completed this magnificent structure, the last, the greatest and the most enduring achievement of his active career. In producing this, his masterpiece, that rare faculty, possessed by few men, discernment, and which was applied with judgment approaching inspiration. Every man under his direction was selected with reference to his fitness for the special work so admirably forestalled. Who could have found a better stone mason than H. D. Kullman, of Baltimore; a better mill man than J. H. Tinley & Co., of Baltimore; a better foreman carpenter than his own son, Munson, who, assisted by his brother, Victor, directed affairs absolutely during the illness of his father.

A brief description of the structure may interest those who are unable to be present at the dedication service. Nine months ago to-day

work of J. C. F. Trschell, of Philadelphia, is a model of mechanical installation; the sheet metal, the work of Chas. H. Blaine, of Wilmington, Del., is wrought with wondrous care and skill; the hardwood finish, the work of Michael Bowden, of Perryville, cannot be surpassed. Taking all in all the ecclesiastical effect is a marvel of satisfying completeness.

The Sunday school room must be seen to be appreciated; the main room is about twenty-five feet high, five class rooms and the infant room adjoining being temporarily separated by folding doors, which upon occasion can be all thrown open and one immense room made of the whole space. It is furnished with the very latest modern improved folding chairs. A second story space also opens into the Sunday school room; this will be used for the adult Bible class; adjoining this is a private study for the pastor. In the basement we find perhaps the most novel features contained in the building. The great space under the entire Sunday school room is arranged for entertainments of any sort. A spacious kitchen, equipped, is intended for festivals, suppers, etc. Abundant arrangements have been provided for toilet and retiring rooms. The seating throughout is comfortable, and will accommodate fully 700 persons, while the unobstructed capacity of the Sunday school room is 650; the aisles are wide, and the exits from all portions of the building will meet all requirements.

The beauty of the exterior is in full keeping with the furnishings and decorations of the interior work and shows exquisite and refined taste, and a harmony and beauty that even the most casual observer cannot fail to note, and by reason of its majestic strength will stand for ages, and to future generations will bear testimony to the large-hearted and noble-minded donors, Mr. and Mrs. Seneca, and cause their names to be ever cherished and held in loving remembrance.

This volume contains (1) a Record of Baptisms, and (2) a Record of Marriages

1. The *Record of Baptisms* contains six columns. That on the extreme left contains the date of the baptism. In the second column the name of the baptized person is to be recorded; and, if an infant, the name of its parents or natural guardians. The next column is for the date of the birth of the baptized person, which should always be recorded in the case of Infant Baptism. The next column is for the residence of the party baptized; the next for the name of the officiating minister; and the last, for the names of one or more witnesses. These last are sometimes important in legal questions, and it is well to insert them.

As baptism is the rite of initiation into the Christian Church, this record should be carefully kept, that due care may be taken of the spiritual interests of the baptized persons.

2. The *Record of Marriages* contains six columns, the use of which can be readily learned by inspection. This record also should be kept with great care.

After such examination as our brief time would allow, we hereby express our judgment that a series of uniform Church Records of great importance, and that those shown to us by Dr. McClintock are such as the interests of the Church require.

We earnestly recommend them to the preachers and members of the Church, and hope they will be universally adopted.
