about the middle of Septemb And to send the Result of the Liber H. H. s^d Assembly unto the Gou & Councell of Virginia w^{th} all pos-

sible speed they may.

And Lastly Jt is Concluded on, that for the mutuall satisfaction of both the s^d Gouerm^{ts} That the Gou^r & Councell of both Collonies, shall bee sworne solemnly, by Commis^{rs} appoynted on eyther side, to take their Oath, to doe their vttmost endeauo^{rs} to cause the s^d Law for stinting (if confirmed) to bee duly executed, according to the true intent & meaning of the propositions.
