Commissions of a Letter of Marque & Reprisal issued Jonathan Parsons master of the Sloop called the Fly mounting two Swivel Guns navigated by six men, belonging to Samuel & Robert Purviance and others of Baltimore also to Henry Geddis master of the Schooner called the Savage mounting four Carriage Guns & four Swivels navigated by twelve men belonging to Sam^l & Robert Purviance and others of Baltimore
