- 3. An Engrost bill to confirm to William Gray of Calvert County, a small parcell of land lying in the said County sold by Robert Brooke to the said Gray now in the possession of the said Gray.
- 4. An Engrost bill to confirm a tract of land therein mentioned to the Rector or Minister of S<sup>t</sup> John's Parish in Baltemore County and his Successors for ever.
- 5. An Engrost bill for the Encouragement of an Iron Manufacture within this Province.
- 6. An Engrost bill for the better Supporting the Magis- p. 160 trates in the administration of Justice within this Province.
- 7. An Engrost Bill Explaining & Declareing particularly what Laws were repealed by an Act Entituled An Act Declareing all Laws heretofore made w<sup>ch</sup> have been reenacted this Sessions of Assembly to be repealed and reviving the Act for relief of Ann Arundell County.
