I have by the Advice of his L<sup>dps</sup> Council of State thought fit to Prorogue this Assembly to the first Tuesday in November next and You are to take Notice You are prorogued to that Day accordingly

Thus Ends this Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis the seventeenth day of June and ending the eighth day of July following in the thirty second Year of his Lordships Dominion and in the twentieth Year of his Majestys Reign Annoq Domini 1746
