PETITION FROM SUNDRY INHABITANTS OF ST. PAUL'S PARISH, BALTIMORE COUNTY, FOR LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY TO HIRE AN ORGANIST, CIRCA 1760-1761

This undated petition from sundry inhabitants OF St. Paul's Parish, Baltimore County, sought LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE A TAX OF 8 POUNDS OF TOBACCO ON THE TAXABLE INHABITANTS OF THE PARISH TO HIRE AN ORGANIST TO PLAY "THE VERY GOOD ORGAN" AT ST. PAUL'S CHURCH. ALTHOUGH ADDRESSED TO GOVERNOR SHARPE AND BOTH HOUSES OF THE AS-SEMBLY, IT APPARENTLY WAS NEVER PRESENTED IN EITHER HOUSE. FROM AN ANALYSIS OF THE SIGNERS IT IS POSSIBLE TO DATE IT 1760-1761. SEE PAGE CVI FOR A DIS-CUSSION OF THE MATTER.
