bill for payment of the tobacco as aforesaid, wherein you are to be very cautious and circumspect, that you accept of none but responsible persons (soe neare as you can) to become purchasers or surcties for them that shall desire the same. For all which this shall be your sufficient warrant—Given under my hand at Mattapony Sewall the second day of February in the eighth yeare of our dominion &c. Annoque Dmi. 1682."

"The councill order proclamation to issue to certify all people, that if they are any way prejudiced or damaged by the miscarriage of the deputy surveyor if they doe not seek for reparation in six months time after such miscarriage is committed, the person that is so prejudiced to be left remediless against the surveyor generall or his deputys, six months from the date of this proclamation for what is already done and six months from the time that the injury is done afterwards."

"Ordered that all inquisitions returned upon writts of mandamus issued forth of the chancery court of records by order of this board, be by the hon'ble the secretarys (after reading in the provinciall court) returned unto this board for their perusall and further order therein."
