At a SESSION of the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of MARYLAND, begun and held at the CITY of ANNAPOLIS, on Monday, the 3d of November, and ended the 19th day of December, 1800, the following laws were enacted.

C H A P. I.

An ACT to revive the levy court for Baltimore county.

Passed 19th of Dec. 1800.

THEREAS it is represented to this general affembly, that from the late prevailing contagious Preamble. fever in the city of Baltimore a sufficient number of the justices of the levy court for Baltimore county did not meet within the time prescribed by law to adjust, assess and apportion, the expences of their county for this prefent year, whereby the powers of the faid justices to discharge the above and many other duties enjoined by law have ceased; for remedy whereof,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court for Justices to Baltimore county, or a majority of them, shall, on some day in this present year, meet at the court- meet, &c. house of the faid county, and then and there discharge the several duties directed or required by law to be done by the faid court, and they may, in their discretion, adjourn from time to time for that purpose; and all the acts and proceedings of the said levy court, so to be done, shall be as good and as effectual in law, to all intents and purposes whatsoever, as if the said justices had met within the time by law directed.

An ACT to aid and revive the proceedings of the orphans court of Paffed 10th of Dec. 1800. Talbot county.

THEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that the orphans court of Talbot coun- Preamble. ty stood adjourned until Thursday the twenty-third day of October, eighteen hundred, and that from the badness of the weather, and other unavoidable accidents, no one of the justices of the faid court attended to call the same according to adjournment as aforesaid, whereby all process and proceedings in the faid court were discontinued; for remedy whereof,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all the judgments, rules, entries, Judgments, &c. acts, process and proceedings, depending in the said court on the day aforesaid, shall and the same revived, &c. are hereby revived, reinstated, and placed on the docket and under the jurisdiction of the court, in the same manner, state and condition, as they would have been if the said court had met on the said twenty-third day of October, eighteen hundred, and the faid judgments, rules, entries, acts, process and proceedings, had been duly continued by regular and lawful adjournments from time to time.

C H A P.

An ACT to revive and aid the proceedings of the orphans court of Paffed 19th of Dec. 1800.

Saint-Mary's county.

THEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that the orphans court of Saint-Mary's Preamble. county flood adjourned until Tuesday the eleventh day of February last, and that no one of the justices of faid court attended to call the same according to adjournment as aforesaid, whereby

all process and proceedings in the said court were discontinued; for remedy whereof,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That all the judgments, rules, entries, Judgments, revived, &c. acts, process and proceedings, depending in the said court on the day aforesaid, shall be and the same are hereby revived, and shall be in the same state and condition, to all intents and purposes, as
