

1 DELEGATE PENNIMAN: I do.

2 THE PRESIDENT: Any objection to modifying the
3 amendment by adding a comma at the end of line 19?

4 The Chair hears none so the amendment will be so
5 modified.

6 Any further questions? Are you ready for the
7 question.

8 Delegate Carson.

9 DELEGATE CARSON: Mr. Chairman, it couldn't be
10 more petty, but if ~~this~~ is going to be part of the Consti-
11 tution, there ought to be a comma in line 5 after "provisions"
12 and a comma in line 9 after "1968".

13 THE PRESIDENT: I believe that is the policy fol-
14 lowed by the Committee on Style, is it, Delegate Penniman?

15 DELEGATE PENNIMAN: That is correct.

16 THE PRESIDENT: Any objection to adding the
17 comma after the word "provisions" in line 5 and line 9,
18 after "1968"?

19 Do you object, Delegate Sybert?

20 DELEGATE SYBERT: I don't object, Mr. President,
21 but I suggest if you add a comma after the word "provisions"
