

1 I cannot be sure at the moment that they will
2 be available for you Wednesday, but they will be very shortly
3 thereafter, if not on Wednesday.

4 Only one copy will be signed, this on the advice
5 of Dr. Ratof of the Hall of Records who urges
6 that there not be a duplicate signed, so that there never
7 exists the slightest doubt as to which is the original
8 Constitution.

9 There will be a ceremony. It is a solemn
10 occasion. It should move off with dispatch and dignity.
11 The accommodations will be crowded, therefore the number
12 of guests we can have in the chamber is very very limited.
13 We cannot have the number we had on opening day.
14 We will have to have the table in the well of the chamber,
15 and we want delegates to be able to sign without being
16 jostled and crowded, and to have their photograph taken
17 at the moment of signing.

18 The signing will be alphabetical. We will
19 simply go right down the row, one after the other, in the
20 alphabetical sequence.

21 The urgency is for all of us to be here, and
