Which was read, assented to, and sent to the House of Delegates.

The President announced the order of the day, being the bill entitled, an Act to add additional sections to the Code of Public General Laws, title "Small Pox ;"

Mr. Kimmel moved to postpone the bill ;

The Senate proceeded to the consideration of the bill entitled, an Act to repeal the 4th, 7th, 15th, 16th and 20th sections of Article 4th of the Public Local Laws of the city of Baltimore, relating to the qualifications of electors in said city, and regulating the time for holding elections for Mayor and Members of the City Council, and the terms of and the time for entering upon the duties of said office, and to re-enact the same with amendments ;

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED :

Section 7, line 2d, strike out two thousand five hundred dollars, and insert "three thousand dollars."

Section 20, line 5, strike out the word setting, and insert the word "sitting."

Title, line 4, strike out the word elections, and insert the word "electors."

Which were read and adopted.

Mr. Henkle submitted the following amendment :

In 4th line after the word "on," insert "the same day in ;"

Which was read and adopted.
