Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate a gas light company in the town of Frostburg, Allegany county.

On motion of Mr. Martin,

Leave was granted to the St. Mary's county delegation to report a bill to increase the number of County Commissioners of St. Mary's county.

On motion of Mr. Carroll,

Leave was granted to the Baltimore county delegation to increase the number of County Commissioners of Baltimore county.

On motion of Mr. Purnell,

Leave was granted to the Worcester county delegation and Mr. Gordy, of Wicomico, to introduce a bill amending the Act incorporating the Worcester Railroad.
