introduce a bill to increase the number of County Commissioners for Prince George's county.

Ordered, That a committee of five be appointed by the Speaker of this House to visit the city of Baltimore to examine into the affairs of the Tobacco Warehouse.

Which was adopted, and the following constituted said Committee: Messrs. Martin, Owens, Duvall, Wells, Hilton.

Mr. Sanner submitted the following order:

Ordered, That a committee of five be appointed by the Speaker, to whom shall be referred the message of the Governor, together with the accompanying documents, for the purpose of distributing the several matters therein contained to appropriate Committees.
