A bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of A. C. N. Matthews.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Middletown," to follow section 233.

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Biggs, Henkle and Clarke.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal section 615, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Jurors," and reenact the same with amendments.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Montgomery county to subscribe to the capital stock of turnpike companies in Montgomery county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Sellman, Hyland and Welch.

A bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Baltimore and Caroline counties to provide for the renewal and restoration of the registration books of said counties.

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators from Baltimore, Caroline and Frederick counties.

A bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower Richard T. West to place two gates on the public road through his farm, in Montgomery county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Sellman, Hyland and Welch.

A bill entitled an Act to amend chapter 424, of the Laws passed January session, 1868, incorporating the town of Berlin, in Worcester county.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Senators from Worcester, Howard and Cecil counties.

A bill entitled an Act to declare and make public highways of the foot of all the streets resting on Light street wharf, and to give the Harbor-Master control thereof.
