A bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Howard Mutual Life Insurance and Trust Company of Baltimore, with proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out section 5, and insert in lieu thereof the following:

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted*, That there shall be a guarantee capital of at least one hundred thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of twenty dollars each, which shall be personal property, transferable on the books of the Company, in conformity with its by-laws; that the said guarantee capital stock shall be invested in the securities of the United States, the State of Maryland, or the City of Baltimore, either one or all of said securities, and the same deposited with the Treasurer of this State, as a guarantee for the payment of the policies of insurance issued by said Company; and the said Company,
