Endorsed, "Considered, read a third time and rejected for want of a constitutional majority, re-considered and passed by yeas and nays."

A bill entitled an Act to amend Article 28, of the Code of Public General Laws, title, "County Commissioners," by adding the following sections,

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendments:"
