AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 4, line 3, strike out the word "Treasury," and insert "the place where made payable."

Section 4, line 8, strike out all after line 8 to the word "the," in line 12, and insert "not less than thirty days' notice to the holders of such overdue debt, that on a day named in said notice."

Section 5, line 4, insert after "certificate" "the meeting at some future day."

Which was adopted.
