

“ Shall the previous question be now put ? ”

It was decided in the affirmative.

The second section of the bill as amended, was then read, and

The bill, as amended, read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following bills, severally endorsed, “ Passed by yeas and nays : ”

A bill, entitled a supplement to an Act, entitled an Act to incorporate the Hillen Road Company of Baltimore county, passed at January Session, 1854, chapter 99, and supplements thereto, passed at January Session, 1860, chapter 51, and at January Session, 1867, chapter 214,

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Baltimore county delegation.

A bill, entitled a further supplement to the Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Fredericktown Savings' Institution, passed at December Session, 1827, chapter 142, of the General Assembly of Maryland, repealing the fifth section thereof, and re-enacting the same, with amendments.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
