The bill, entitled an Act to exempt Caroline and Kent counties from the operation of chapter 231, of the Public Local Laws, entitled an Act to protect fish and wild fowl in the waters of Queen Anne's, Kent, Caroline and Harford counties, passed at the January Session, 1870,

Mr. Ford, of Queen Anne's, submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 1, line 2, after the word "Caroline," insert "Queen Anne's."

Which was adopted.

The bill, as amended, was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
