And be it enacted, That said County Comto pay inter't missioners shall, in each and every year prior to the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, levy upon the assessable property of Frederick county such sum of money as may be sufficient to pay the interest on the bonds issued under the provisions of this Act, and in the year eighteen hundred and eightynine, and in each and every year thereafter until all of said bonds are redeemed, the said County Commissioners shall levy upon the assessable property of said county, a tax of not less than two cents on every hundred dollars thereof.

Excl'sive use applied exclusively to the payment of the principal and interest of the said bonds authorized by this Act. and to the costs of collection of the said tax, which said tax shall be collected as all other taxes are collected in said county.

## CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT to authorize Marcellus W. J. Larmore to settle his accounts as guardian to Ambrose H. D. Larmore, and to pay over all money due said ward.

Authorized to pass final account.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Marcellus W. J. Larmore, guardian to Ambrose H. D. Larmore, a minor, be and he is hereby authorized to pass his final account, as guardian, before the Orphan's Court of Somerset county, and to pay and deliver over to the said Ambrose II.
