FOR STATE OFFICERS.

Salaries of
State Officers

For the salary of the Governor of Maryland, four thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the Secretary of State, two thousand dollars; for the salary of the Comptroller of the Treasury Department, two thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the Chief Clerk to the Comptroller, sixteen hundred dollars; for the salaries of the three assistant clerks to the Comptroller, twelve hundred dollars each, thirty-six hundred dollars; for the salary of the Treasurer of Maryland, two thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the clerk to the Treasurer, sixteen hundred dollars; for the salary of the State Librarian, fifteen hundred dollars; for the salary of the Commissioner of the Land Office, fifteen hundred dollars.

JUDICIARY.

Salaries of
Judiciary.

For the salaries of the Chief Judges of the first seven Judicial Circuits, three thousand five hundred dollars each, twenty-four thousand five hundred dollars; for the salaries of fourteen Associate Judges of the first seven Judicial Circuits, two thousand eight hundred dollars each, thirty-nine thousand two hundred dollars; for the Special Judge of the Court of Appeals from Baltimore city, the Chief Judge, and four Associate Judges of the Supreme Bench of Baltimore city, each three thousand five hundred dollars, twenty-one thousand dollars; for the salary of the Attorney General, three thousand dollars; for the Commissions to State's Attorneys, two thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary; to the Sheriff and Crier of the Court of Appeals, one thousand dollars, or so much thereof as the Clerk of the Court of Appeals may certify him entitled to receive; for the salary of the State Reporter, one thousand dollars.
