

On motion of Mr. Bond,

Leave was granted to Select Committee, already appointed, to report a bill, repealing so much of Article IV. of the Public Local Laws, as relates to the Inspection of Tobacco, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

On motion of Mr. Clark, of Baltimore City,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill, to enable the Rev. Richard Fuller, of Baltimore City, to convey certain effects and property by his last will and testament, to the Eutaw-Place Baptist Church, of Baltimore.

On motion of Mr. Johnson,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Johnson, Langrell and Franklin, to report a bill authorizing the Trustees of the Methodist Protestant Church, in Salisbury, Wicomico county, to sell and convey certain property belonging to them.

On motion of Mr. McColgan,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill, incorporating the Lubricating Car Axle Company of Baltimore.

On motion of Mr. Miller,

Leave was granted to a Select Committee heretofore appointed, to introduce a bill, entitled an Act authorizing Wm. H. B. Dorsey, of Carroll county, to close a certain piece of road on his premises, known as the Old Buffalo road.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill, to amend the charter of the Baltimore and Drum Point Railroad Company, by increasing the number of the Directors of the said company.
