A bill, entitled an Act to repeal section 7, of the Act passed the 8th day of March, 1856, chapter 148, entitled "an Act to incorporate the Kent County Railroad Company," and to re-enact the same, with amendments.

Mr. Young, Chairman of a Select Committee, to whom was referred

The Senate bill, entitled an Act directing the County Commissioners of Washington county to issue bonds to raise money to build a Court House, in said county, and appointing Commissioners to contract to erect the same,

Reported back the same, favorably, from a majority of said Committee, without amendments.

Said bill being upon a second reading,

Mr. Whitson, from said Committee, submitted proposed amendments as a minority report.
