The following Acts, having passed both Branches of the General Assembly, were this day submitted to his Excellency, the Governor, for his approval :

An Act to repeal certain sections of, and amend the charter of the Old Town Savings' Institution of Baltimore, as contained in the Act, entitled an Act to incorporate the Old Town Savings' Institution of Baltimore, passed at January Session, 1858, and repeal an Act passed at January Session, 1860, entitled an Act to amend an Act to incorporate the Old Town Savings' Institution of Baltimore, passed at January Session, 1858, and to re-enact parts of the same with amendments, and to change the name of said body corporate, to the Old Town Bank of Baltimore.
