**JUNE 1812.** 

#### CHAPTER I.

CHAP. 1.

An Act authorising the several Banks in this State to Loan Money to Passed Jun 18 the United States. Lib. TH. No. 3, fol. 337.

1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Authorised is lead each of the several banking institutions within the state of Mary-third of enpired land, be and hereby is authorised to loan to the United States, any sum of money not exceeding in amount one third of its capital actually paid in.

2. And BE IT ENACTED, That all loans hitherto made by any Former loans to Lanking institution of this state, to the United States, are hereby declared to be as legal and valid, to all intents and purposes, as if such loans had been made by and with the consent of the legislature of this state.

## CHAP. II.

A Supplement to an act\*, entitled, An act to establish a Bank and in- Bassed June 183 corporate a Company under the name of The Cumberland Bank of \* 1821, ch. 207. Allegany. Lib. TH. No. 3, fol. 337.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Name and title of bank changed. the name and title of the Cumberland Bank of Allegany, be and the same is hereby changed and altered to that of the Cumberland Bank of Alleghany; and the subscribers to said bank, their successors and assigns, shall, by that name and style, be made a corporation and body politic, with all the rights, powers and privileges, as by the original act to which this is a supplement are given.

#### CHAP. III.

A Supplement to the actt, entitled, An act to incorporate a Bank to be Passed June 18. called The Farmers Bank of Somerset and Worcester. Lib. TH. No. 3, fol. 338.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Directors authothe board of directors of the bank, appointed agreeably to the president and seventh section of the said law, at their first meeting, and at their other officers first meeting after every annual election, shall have power to appoint a president for the said bank, and all other officers requisite
