## LEVIN WINDER, ESQUIRE, GOVERNOR.

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That CHAP. 193. the treasurer of the western shore shall and he is hereby authorised and required, to pay the several persons, their executors, ad- Treasurer authorized to nov. ministrators, assigns or order, or to such of them as shall offer to receive the same, the several sums of current money allowed to them respectively, as they appear to be settled and ascertained by the said journal of accounts, out of any money now in the treasury, or that shall come into the treasury, subject to the appropriation of the general assembly.

## CHAP. CXCIV.

An Act providing for the appointment of Bailiff's for the City of Passed Jan. 2, 1813 Baltimore. Lib. TH. No. 3, fol. 546.

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That pointed. the mayor of the city of Baltimore be and he is hereby authorised to appoint, during pleasure, not less than twenty-five, and not exceeding one hundred bailiffs, for the purpose of aiding in the preservation of the peace, the maintenance of the laws, and the ad-

vancement of the police and good government of said city.

2. And he it enacted. That the mayor and city council of Mayor and city council to preseribe their duties scribe the duties, designate the badges and weapons, and provide for the compensation of said bailiffs, in such manner as effectually to secure the important objects of their appointment.

## CHAP. CXCV.

An Act to continue in force the Acts of Assembly which would expire Passed Jan 2, 1815 with the present Session. Lib. TH. No. 3, fol. 546.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland. That all Acts continued. such acts, and parts of acts of assembly, as would expire with the present session of assembly, be and the same are hereby continued for one year from the passage of this act, and until the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter.
