CHAP. CXXI.

An Act for the payment of the Journal of Accounts. Lib. TH. No. Passed Dec 25. 2, fol. 117.

WHEREAS it appears by the journal of accounts of this session, Preamble that there is due from the state the sum of twenty-two thousand

eight hundred and forty dollars and seventy-three cents;

2. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore shall and he is hereby authorised to pay the several persons, their executors, administrators, assigns or order, or to such of them as shall offer to receive the same, the several sums of current money allowed to them respectively, as they appear to be settled and ascertained by the said journal of accounts, out of any money now in the treasury, or that shall come into the treasury, subject to the appropriation of the general assembly.
