town, there to be fold at the market hours, to wit, from any time in the morning CHAP. to twelve at noon.

- III. And be it enacted, That no person shall presume to buy, or cause to be Penalty on persons have bought, of any person or persons bringing to the said town, and within two ingounts miles thereof, or having brought any kind of victuals or provisions whatsoever to market, &c. the faid town for fale, except as before excepted, either upon the above flated market days, or any other days of the week during the time of the above stated market hour, at any other place whatfoever but at or in the faid market-houfe, under the penalty of fifty shillings current money for every such offence.
- IV. And he it enacted, That if any servant or slave shall, after the aforesaid On servants, first day of January, in the year seventeen hundred and eighty-five, buy any kind acof victuals or provisions bringing to the said town for sale, and within two miles of the faid town, or brought to the faid town for fale as aforefaid, except as aforesaid, either upon the market days above stated, or any other days of the week during the time of the above appointed market hours, at any other place whatsoever other than the said market-house, the owner of the said servant or flave shall be fined the sum of twenty-five shillings for every such offence.
- V. and be it enasted. That no person whatsoever, after the time aforesaid. On persons bringing or fending, or having brought or fent, any provisions or victuals to the ieiling, &c. said town for sale, shall sell, or cause to be sold, the said victuals or provisions, fo bringing or fending, or brought or fent, as aforefaid, to the faid town, or within two miles thereof, either by land or water, except as before excepted, under the penalty of twenty-five shillings.

VI. And he it enacted. That if any person shall hereafter presume to slaughter On slaughter. or butcher any cattle kind, theep or hog, in or near about the faid market-house, ing cattle, act he or they, so doing, shall forfeit and pay ten shillings current money for every fuch offence.

VII. And he it enacted, That if any person shall, after the time aforesaid, On putting put their own or any other person's horse or horses, mare or mares, gelding or horses under market-nouse, geldings, into or under the faid market-house, on any pretence whatsoever, he, &c. the or they, shall forfeit and pay five shillings current money for every such offence.

VIII. And he it enamed, That the justices of the orphans court for Kent Justices to appear on the major part of them, shall meet and assemble at the court-house ac. of the faid county, on or before the first day of January, in the year seventeen hundred and eighty-five, and yearly and every year thereafter, in the month of October in such year, and there nominate and appoint a person of good repute and skill to be clerk of the said market; and in case the clerk so appointed shall die, refign, or refuse to act, or be rendered incapable of acting as aforesaid, by misbehaviour, removal or otherwise, the said justices, or the major part of them, shall, as soon as conveniently may be thereafter, meet together, and nominate and appoint another such person, as aforesaid, as clerk of said market for the residue of the said year.

IX. Provided always, and be it enacted, That every clerk, so as aforesaid Provide. appointed shall, before he acts as such, take the following oath, or affirmation if a quaker, menonist or dunker, nicolite or new quaker, before some justice of peace for faid county: "I, A. B. do swear, or solemnly, fincerely and " truly, declare and affirm, that I will diligently and faithfully, according to the "best of my skill and judgment, execute and perform all and singular the duties " of clerk of faid market, without favour, affection, or partiality; and that I will "not, directly or indirectly, receive any fee or reward for doing the duties of

" clerk of faid market, but what is or shall be allowed by law."

X. And be it enacted, That the clerk of the said market shall have sufficient Clerk's duty. power and authority to take care and charge of the said market and market-house Bbbbb aforesaid,
