An ACT for the inspection of salted provisions exported and im- Pathal January ported from and to the town of Baltimore.

*HEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that great impo- Preamble. fitions daily arise from the exportation and fale of unfound falted provisions, and there not being any regulations for the prevention of such frauds: Therefore,

II. Be it enacted, by the general affembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Baltimore-town, or the major part of them, shall meet between the first &c. and twentieth days of March next, and between the first and twentieth days of March yearly, and every year thereafter, during the continuance of this act, and then nominate and appoint a person of good repute, and skilful in the goodness, quality, and well curing of salted beef, pork, and sish of every kind, to be inspector of salted provisions, within the said town, for the year ensuing.

III. And he it enacted, That every commissioner, who shall vote for the said Their oath officer, shall take the following oath before he shall proceed to the nomination and appointment of the faid officer: "I, A. B. do swear, that I will faithfully, "honestly and impartially, nominate and appoint such person to be inspector of " falted provisions within the faid town, as I think in my judgment and con-" fcience is fit and capable of executing the faid office."

IV. And he it enacted. That in case of the death of such officer so appoint- How vacant ed, or his refusal or neglect to act, the said commissioners, or the major part of cier are to be filled. them, shall, as soon as conveniently may be thereafter, meet together and appoint one other fuch person as aforesaid, in the stead of the person so dying, or refusing or neglecting to act, for the residue of the year; and if the said commisfioners shall neglect and omit to nominate and appoint such officer, then the governor and council may appoint fuch officer, who shall be qualified agreeably to the directions of this act, and have the like power and authority as if he had been by the faid commissioners nominated and appointed.

V. and be it enacted, That all falted beef, pork, and fish of every kind, Boos, &c. to brought or imported into the faid town, from any part of this state, or any one be made merof the United States, or from any foreign port whatever, from and after the first day of April next, shall be made merchantable, found, and fit for use.

VI. And be it enacted, That from and after the first day of November Barrels to be next, all beef and pork barrels brought to, or imported into, Baltimore-town, mide god materials, ac. from any part of this state, shall be made of good seasoned materials, well made, tightened with twelve hoops, sufficiently nailed with four nails in each chine hoop, and three nails in each upper bilge hoop, sufficient to hold pickle, and of the following dimensions, viz. the staves to be of the length of twentynine inches, and eighteen inches diameter at the head: All fish barrels imported or brought in as aforefaid, shall be made of good seasoned materials, well made, tightened with twelve hoops, fufficiently nailed in manner aforefaid, fufficient to hold pickle, and of the following dimensions, to wit, the staves of the length of twenty-eight inches, and eighteen inches diameter at the head.

VII. And he it enasted, That all persons packing and curing beef or pork Quantity to as aforesaid, shall put in the said barrels the sull quantity of two hundred and be put in each barrel, &c. twenty pounds net weight; and that if any person or persons shall pack any beef or pork barrel with a less quantity than is directed by this act to be contained in the barrels of the fize and dimensions aforesaid, he or they shall forfeit, if the deficiency be three pounds, fix-pence current money, if fix pounds, one shilling and fix-pence, and fix-pence per pound for every pound deficient above fix pounds.

VIII. and he it enacted, That all and every barrel of beef, pork and fish, To be view brought to the said town for sale or exportation, shall be submitted to the view
