

To receive and pay out proceeds of tax levies. 66. The said Treasurer shall receive and keep, and pay over according to the directions of law or the order of the County Commissioners the proceeds of all taxes levied in the county, and shall keep full accounts of all moneys received and paid by him, and of all matters relating to the duties of his office, with all vouchers relating thereto, and upon the expiration of his term shall transfer and deliver to his successor in office all books, accounts and papers of every kind connected therewith.

To collect State and county taxes. 66A. It shall be the duty of the Treasurer, in addition to the duties now required of him, to collect all State and county taxes to be hereafter levied in Caroline County, and said Treasurer may appoint one or more deputies, who shall be authorized to act in his place, for whose acts he shall be responsible and to whom he may pay such compensation as he may deem proper, to be deducted from his salary.

Further duties imposed. 68B. It shall be the duty of the Treasurer each year, as soon as the annual levy is made, to give public notice thereof by advertisement inserted in two newspapers printed and published in said county, and having the largest circulation, and the taxes so levied shall be due and payable on the first day of September of the year in which they are levied; it shall be the duty of said Treasurer in the months of September, October and November in each year to sit at least one day at the principal town in each election district of said county for the purpose of receiving taxes; due notice of such sittings shall be given by advertisement as hereinbefore provided; and he shall report to the County Commissioners at their first regular meeting in each month the amount of taxes, State and county separately, collected by him up to the date of such report, and the amount of disbursements made and the balance in hand, and he shall deposit at least once a week in the Denton National Bank, or some other national bank of Maryland, all taxes received or collected by him up to the date of such deposit, the portion due the State to his credit as collector of State taxes and the portion due the county to his credit as Treasurer of Caroline County; and he shall once a month from and after the first day of October in each year, deliver to the County Commissioners to be forwarded to the State Treasurer, his check for the amount of State taxes to his credit in bank, and the money deposited to the Treasurer of Caroline County shall only be drawn out upon his check in payment of debts and accounts due by said county, duly approved and passed by said County Commissioners and by them ordered to be paid; and

Moneys to be drawn from bank on his check only.
