Fees of the
justice of the
peace.

100F. That the justice of the peace, for the special services under the provisions of this Act, shall be entitled to one dollar for each case; and the two disinterested persons so summoned, each seventy-five cents per day for the time necessary spent by them in investigating each claim; said costs to be paid by the claimant in each case; provided, that in all cases where damages are awarded the fees paid by claimants shall be included in the amount of such damage.

Funds over a
certain
amount to go
to public
schools.

100G. That at the end of each year, if the County Treasurer shall have in his hands moneys collected from dog taxes for the payment of claims as heretofore mentioned more than two hundred dollars, after the payment of all such claims, he shall immediately pay the same to the Treasurer of the Board of County School Commissioners of Allegany County, to be used for public school purposes; and the collector shall receive the sum of fifteen cents for the collection on each dog, bitch and spayed bitch.

Constable to
kill all unli-
censed dogs.

100H. That in case any owner or keeper of any dog, bitch or spayed bitch shall fail to pay the tax levied upon any of said animals for the term of three months after the same shall become due and payable thereon, the constable in each election district shall kill all dogs upon which the tax has not been paid, and shall receive twenty-five cents for killing each dog, out of said fund aforesaid; and all of said dog taxes shall be held to be due and payable on or before the first day of September in the year 1905, and on or before said day in each and every year thereafter.

100I. That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 630.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 771 and 773 of Article 4 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Baltimore City," sub-title "Miscellaneous Laws," sub-division "Police Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 771 and 773 of Article 4, Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Miscellaneous Laws," sub-division "Police Commissioners," as amended and re-enacted by Chapter 123 of the Acts of 1898, be repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:
