

Prohibiting

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall not be lawful for the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Garrett County, Maryland, to issue license to any person or persons to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at any place in Garrett County within three miles of Lower Savage School House, in the village of Bond, Garrett County, Maryland.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 675.

AN ACT to provide for the examination and auditing annually of the accounts of the Board of County School Commissioners for Kent County, the Trustees of the Poor of Kent County and the County Treasurer of Kent County, and to require the appointment of an auditing committee with power to summons and swear witnesses in relation thereto.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall be the duty of the judges of the Circuit Court of Kent County, annually, on or after the year 1904, during the April term of said court, to appoint from among the taxable inhabitants of said county, and without the least reference to their political opinions, and of approved character for competency and integrity, three persons who shall constitute an auditing committee, whose duty it shall be to examine carefully the accounts, vouchers, books and papers of the Board of County School Commissioners and Treasurer thereof for Kent County, the Trustees of the Poor of Kent County and County Commissioners of Kent County, and to report the same in duplicate, one of said reports to be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court for said county, and one with the County Commissioners of said county; and the said County Commissioners are hereby directed and empowered to publish said report, immediately upon the filing of the same, in two newspapers in Kent County at their legal rates for such length of time as the County Commissioners shall deem expedient.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it shall be the duty of the three persons, so as aforesaid appointed, within thirty days after their appointment, to take and subscribe before the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Kent County, an oath to well
