

mitteeman of each election district and the committeeman shall be elected at each primary election for each of the election districts of Montgomery County, and each candidate for committeeman shall pay one dollar to the Supervisors of Elections.

Form of ballot. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the form of the ballot, with the names of the candidates for the several offices to be filled or delegates to be voted for, shall be furnished by the governing bodies of said political parties to the said Supervisors of Elections at least fifteen days before the day upon which said primary is held, and shall be published at least one time in two or more papers printed in said county.

Ballots to be used. SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That the Supervisors of Elections shall furnish to the judges all the ballots to be used in said primaries, and also the blanks upon which their returns are to be made. The said Supervisors shall have said ballots printed in accordance with the provisions of the preceding section; each of said ballots shall be signed by, or stamped, with a fac-simile of the signature of the president of the Board of Supervisors of Elections; the said ballots shall then be put up in sealed packages, one package for each political parties, in each of the election precincts of said county; each of such packages shall contain three ballots for each voter of said party in the precinct for which such package is intended. The number of ballots shall be determined at the first election held hereunder by a certificate to be furnished by the governing body of each of said parties, and thereafter by the poll-book of the last preceding primary election. The packages of ballots for each precinct, prepared as aforesaid, together with the ballot boxes, registry books and necessary blanks for each precinct, shall be delivered to the return judge of each precinct at least two days before the date of said primary election.

Delivery of election paraphernalia.

Duties of return judge. SEC. 5½. *And be it enacted,* That the return judge for each election precinct shall deliver the returns of the said primary election in said precinct to the Board of Supervisors of Elections at Rockville on the Tuesday succeeding the date of said primaries. The Elections Supervisors shall on that day tabulate the vote and certify the result to the governing bodies of the political parties.

Different colors of paper to be used.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted,* That to prevent voters belonging to or acting with one political party from inadvertently or intentionally casting their ballots for candidates for nomination or election as delegates to any nominating convention
