

county, shall pay and return the same as he would money paid for any other purpose, and the said justice of the peace shall destroy said head, so it cannot again be used, fraudulently.

SEC 2 *Be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect In force from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 24.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section one hundred and thirty-five, of article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford county," sub-title "Sheriffs," as amended and re-enacted by chapter three hundred and forty, of the acts passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section one hundred and thirty-five, of article twelve, of the code of Public Local Laws, title, "Harford county," sub-title, "Sheriffs," as amended by chapter three hundred and forty of the act, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, be repealed, amended, and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Sec. 135. He shall be entitled to forty-five cents per day for boarding each prisoner confined in said Jail. For boarding prisoners

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage and continue In force in force for two years.
