

Directors.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That as soon as the County Commissioners of Dorchester county, shall have subscribed, in the name and on behalf of said county, to the capital stock of said company as aforesaid, the said county shall be entitled to two directors in the said company, who shall be appointed by the said County Commissioners, and shall have the same powers, right, duties and privilege as belong to other directors of the said company.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That in the election of directors on the part of the private stockholders, the stock of Dorchester county shall not be voted, nor shall the same be counted in ascertaining the presence of a quorum necessary for such elections.

To be submit-  
ted to voters

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That at the next regular election for members of the House of Delegates, this act shall be submitted to a vote of the persons legally qualified to vote at said election for members of the House of Delegates, and at said election it shall be lawful for each person qualified to vote as aforesaid, besides the vote which he may cast for the candidates at said election, to cast a separate and distinct ballot on which shall be written or printed the words, "for railroad subscription," or the words, "against railroad subscription," as the case may be; and it shall be the duty of the judges of elections in said county, to receive said separate ballots, and deposit the same in boxes different from those in which the ballots cast for candidates at said election are deposited, and the said judges shall accurately count and duly return to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of said county, the number of votes cast for railroad subscription, and the number of votes cast against railroad subscription; and the said clerk shall, within twenty days after the receipt of said returns, announce the result of the said vote by proclamation inserted in the newspapers published in said county.

SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall be published in the newspapers published in the said county, for two months proceeding the next election to be held for members of the House of Delegates, and shall be subject to the approval of a majority of
