

AMENDMENTS TO THE DECLARATION OF RIGHTS AND CONSTITUTION OF
MARYLAND, PROPOSED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 1914, AND
TO BE VOTED ON (SAVE THE LAST) IN NOVEMBER, 1915.

Chapter 390. Proposes to amend Article 15 of the Declaration of Rights. (Authorizes the classification of property for taxation.)

Chapter 416. Proposes to amend the Constitution by adding a new article to follow immediately after Article 11, and to be known as Article 11A. (The "Home Rule" bill.)

Chapter 453. Proposes to amend Article 3 of the Constitution by adding a new section to be known as Section 60. (Relative to the Indeterminate Sentence, Suspension of Sentence, etc.)

Chapter 673. Proposes to amend the Constitution by adding a new article to be entitled Article 16. (Provides for the Referendum.)

Chapter 845.* Proposes to amend section 44, Part 7, of Article 4 of the Constitution, title "Sheriffs."
