district number sixteen, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number seventeen, three justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number eighteen, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number nineteen, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number twenty, two justices of the peace and two constables.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 417.

AN ACT to amend section five of article four of the Constitution of this State.

Section added.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Three-fifths of all the members of the two Houses concurring, that the following section be and the same is hereby proposed as an amendment to the constitution of this State, and if adopted by the legal and qualified voters thereof as herein provided, it shall supersede and stand in the place and instead of section five of article four of said constitution.

SEC. 5. After the election for judges as hereinbefore provided, there shall be held in this State, in every fifteenth year thereafter, on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November of such year, an election for judges as herein provided; and in case of death, resignation, removal or disqualification, by reason of age or otherwise, of any judge, the Governor shall appoint a person duly qualified to fill said office, who shall hold the same until the next general election for members of the General Assem-
