CHAPTER 25.

Passed Ded 31 An act to prevent the erection of Booths within two miles of any Methodist Camp or Quarterly Meeting in the scveral Counties therein mentioned.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Methodist Society hath at different times sustained such disturbance and vexation from disorderly persons, who hath set up booths to sell liquors, and other things, near their public meetings, during the time of divine service, Therefore,

Penalty on bersons erecting booths.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That whosoever, from and after the passage of this act, shall crect a booth for the purpose of selling, or shall sell or dispose of, any spirituous liquor within two miles of any Methodist Camp or Quarterly Meeting, in Dorchester, Cæcil, Kent, Allegany, Calvert, or Washington counties, during the Camp or Quarterly Meeting of the said Methodist Society, shall forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars current money of this state, to be recovered in the county court of the said county by indictment, one half of the sum which may be recovered to be applied to the use of the county, and the other half to be received by the person or persons who shall make information thereof.
