decisions on matters of law, made by the courts of Baltimore city, in relation to the streets in said city, shall stand for hearing at the first term after the transmission of the record.

OATH.

Chapter 114 repeals section 10, and enacts the following as a substitute therefor:

SEC. 1. Every attorney or other practitioner of law, shall in open court, take and subscribe the following oath or affirmation: "I do solemnly swear (or affirm, as the case may be,) that I will at all times demean myself fairly and honorably as an attorney and practitioner of law, that I will bear true allegiance to the State of Maryland, and support the constitution and laws thereof, and that I will bear true allegiance to the United States, and support, protect, and defend the constitution, laws and government thereof as the supreme law of the land, any law or ordinance of this or any State to the contrary notwithstanding; and I do further swear (or affirm) that I will to the best of my abilities protect and defend the Union of the United States, and not allow the same to be broken up and dissolved, or the Government thereof, to be destroyed under any circumstances, if in my power to prevent it; and that I will, at all times, discountenance and oppose all political combinations having for their
