SEC. 26. Each trustee of the almshouse in Saint Mary's county, shall be entitled to mileage, at the rate of five cents a mile on all distances not exceeding twenty miles from his residence to the almshouse computed by the shortest public road for every day he shall necessarily attend to the duties of his office. The county commissioners of said county are hereby authorized and required to levy a sum of money on the taxable property of said county sufficient to pay the same.
