BILLIARDS.

1870, c. 250 repeals section 6 and enacts as follows:

1870, c. 250
License for billiard table.

SEC. 6. A license may be granted to any person who may apply for permission to keep a billiard table, for which license there shall be paid the sum of fifty dollars, and for every additional billiard table kept by the same person or persons, he, she or they shall pay a license of twenty-five dollars; *provided*, that all said additional tables shall be kept in the same apartment; *provided*, that this act shall not apply to any billiard table kept for private use.
