PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS.

ARTICLE I.

ALLEGANY COUNTY.

Almshouse.

- County commissioners to appoint trustees, steward and other officers; to purchase farming materials; to levy for support.
- 2. Trustees to have supervision over almshouse, grounds and inmates; to prescribe who shall be inmates, to report on general condition and expenditures
- May bind out children, delivery of child to relative; bond to support.
- Apprenticeship to last till 21 in males; 18 in females; apprentices to be educated and maintained.
- 5. Orphans' court to have jurisdiction in such cases.

Auctions.

- License; in what cases necessary, cost.
- 7. Only applicable where goods brought or sent from abroad.
- 8. Penalty: how to be recovered
- Penalty; by whom to be recovered.
- Clerk to pay to State treasurer moneys received for licenses, bond liable; clerk's commissions.

Birds and Game.

- What birds are not to be killed; penalty.
- 12 Season for killing pheasants, partridges.
- 13. Woodcock; robin, wild turkey.
- 14. Rabbits,
- Having in possession out of season; molesting nests, penalty; animals or birds for breeding or ornament excepted.
- 16 Fines, how appropriated; refusal to pay
- 17. Arrest of offenders.
- Killing hawk, owl or weasel, rewards.
- 19. Proceedings to recover reward.
- County treasurer to pay upon presentation of certificate.
- 21. Contingent fund to meet such payments.
- 22 Action in case treasurer refuses to pay
