

crossings in a manner satisfactory to the county commissioners of the county where said road is located, it shall be the duty of the said county commissioners to close the old road and grade crossings, and it shall be lawful for such company to close the former grade crossing.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 283.

AN ACT to repeal, amend and re-enact section one, chapter three hundred and eighty-eight, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to prohibit stock from running at large in election district number one of Queen Anne's county.

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section one of chapter three hundred and eighty-eight of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to prohibit stock from running at large on the public roads in school district number six of election district number one of Queen Anne's county," be repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Prohibited

SEC. 1. All horses, mules, cattle, sheep and swine shall be and are by this act prohibited from going at large on any public road or public ground within the limits of election district number one of Queen Anne's county.

Inconsistent acts repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act be and the same are hereby repealed.
