SEC. —. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That said chapter two hundred and forty-two of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-six does not and shall not apply to or authorize the incorporation or construction of any elevated railroad, or of any other railroad, except a surface road, and that no elevated railroad shall be incorporated except under a special charter of the General Assembly of Maryland; and no elevated railroad shall be constructed in or through the city of Baltimore, or in or through any of the counties of the State, except under a special charter of the General Assembly of Maryland.

SEC. —. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 293.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of Elizabeth Catherine Erb, late of Carroll county, of the sum of one hundred dollars, to St. Mary's Reformed Church of Silver Run, Carroll county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sanction of the General Assembly be and the same is hereby given and declared to the bequest of one hundred dollars by Elizabeth Catherine Erb, late of Carroll county, to St. Mary's Reformed Church of Silver Run, Carroll county.
