

CHAPTER 298.

AN ACT to amend and enlarge the powers conferred by the act entitled "An act to incorporate the Associated Professors of Loyola College in the city of Baltimore," passed at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter one hundred and forty-one.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Associated Professors of Loyola College in the city of Baltimore shall, in addition to the powers granted and conferred upon said body corporate by the act to which this is a supplement, be capable in law to take, receive and hold by purchase, sale, gift, lease, devise, bequest or legacy, any real or personal property, and the same to alien, sell and transfer at pleasure; provided that the net annual income of such property heretofore or hereafter so to be acquired shall not at any time exceed the sum of fifteen thousand dollars.

Additional powers.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That the Legislature reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this act or any part thereof at pleasure.

Right to alter

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
