SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Baltimore county may hereafter bid at any sale of real estate for State and county taxes due thereon, and costs, and in case the same is so purchased by them at said sale, that on the final ratification of said sale, a deed shall be made by the collector of taxes for Baltimore county to the said commissioners, who shall hold the same for the use of the county.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That in case said property shall not be redeemed, the county commissioners shall make public sale of said real estate, after due advertisement in one or more of the newspapers printed in said county, when to them it shall seem best so to do, and sell the same to the highest bidder, and the proceeds of such sale shall be received by the treasurer of county, and who shall be authorized, on the full payment of the purchase money, and not before, to execute a good and sufficient deed to the purchaser, and the money arising from such sale shall be accounted for by the said treasurer, as other public money now is, or may hereafter be accounted for according to law.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
