SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said Board of School Commissioners shall apply so much of said sum as may be necessary, to the immediate payment of arrears of salary due to the teachers in said county, and the residue to the liquidation of any debts due by said board on account of the public schools of said county.

How applied.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 364.

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to accept conveyances of and to hold certain property lying on or near Charles street avenue, in Baltimore county, as a public park.

WHEREAS it is proposed by certain property owners in Baltimore county to convey to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore certain property situated on or near Charles street avenue, in Baltimore county, to be held and used only for and as a public park.

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be and they are hereby authorized to accept a deed or deeds of conveyance of and to hold certain property, not exceeding fifty acres, lying on or Charles street avenue, in Baltimore county, from the heirs of Samuel Wyman, Esquire, late of Baltimore county, deceased, from the Peabody Heights Company of Baltimore city, and from William Remington, Esquire, of Baltimore county, or
