CHAPTER 369.

AN ACT to condemn, open, grade and construct Fulton avenue from the north boundary line of Baltimore city to the north easternmost side of Druid Hill avenue at Druid Hill Park, in Baltimore county.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the opening and construction of Fulton avenue from north Boundary avenue to Druid Hill Park is a much needed improvement and a great public necessity, as it would form a direct line of communication between the western and north-western sections of Baltimore city and Druid Hill Park, and give to that portion of the county in the vicinity, and lying west of the Reisterstown turn-pike road, much greater facilities for reaching the Park and the city; therefore—

Make application.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That whenever it may be desirable to have Fulton avenue condemned, opened, graded and constructed from the north boundary line of Baltimore city to the easternmost side of Druid Hill avenue, as the same has been surveyed and laid out under the provisions of an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter four hundred and forty-one, and as shown by
