Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Home for the Aged of Frederick city.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled an Act to amend Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Corporations," sub title "Turnpike, Plank Road and Passenger Railway Companies," by adding a new section thereto, to be known as "Section two hundred and thirty-six A."
